


Windows and Mirrors

For every scenario, reflect on what part is a mirror or a window for you. For each mirror, write how it connects to your own belief and for each window, reflect using the "10 questions to ask when you disagree with the family's practice"



Window A parent comes in and says that her neighbor who also has a 2 ½ year old was showing her the child's work from their program and shows you a pile of worksheets. She would like to know when Mirror you will be doing this kind of work instead of just playing all day. Window At pick up a parent tells you that she has told her three-year old son he is not allowed to play with another child in the program because you mentioned that they had a conflict and were hitting each Mirror other. She would like you to keep them away from one another and tells you she has instructed her son to hit the other child if they come near him. Window A parent comes to you and says that she noticed her almost 3-year old son wearing the plastic high heels from the dress-up clothes when she came to pick him up the day before. She says Mirror she would like you to tell him he is not allowed to wear those anymore.
