Your Questions	Child's Thinking
What?	REMEMBERING Recalls previously learning information;describes, identifies, knows, labels, names, recognizes, selects
What?	UNDERSTANDING Comprehends the meaning of information; explains in own words or actions
How?	APPLYING Uses knowledge or skill in a new situation; applies, uses, produces, solve.
Why?	ANALYZING Breaks information into parts to increase understanding compares, contrasts, relates, separates, distinguishes
Why?	EVALUATING Makes judgments about the value of ideas or materials on the basis of criteria concludes, discriminates, defends, justifies, supports
What?	CREATING Puts ideas or parts together in a new way to create a new meaning or product combines, creates, designs, composes, rewrites
